Day 1

Lednice castle

Lednice castle is a part of the Lednicko-valtický area, natural complex reaching almost 300km². In 18th and 19th century Lichtensteins built it hand in hand with nature. Since 1996, this „garden of Europe“, has been registered in the UNESCO World Heritage list. And no wonder! In addition to beautiful castles in Valtice and Lednice, it includes lots of smaller objects: a romantic ruin of Janův castle, Classicist Forrester's lodge, Appolo's temple with Dorian peristyle, Pond manor, Frontier manor, Belvedere, Colonnade outlook on Reistna, Rendez-vous, called Diana's temple, Temple of the Three Graces, Aqueduct, Obelisk, Water tower and Prayer tower.
